Subject: Regarding COVID 19 Vaccinations at Kerrville

All – Earlier I sent information on spouses, caregivers, non-enrolled Veterans receiving their vaccinations through the VA. When I have more information for providing vaccinations for those folks here in Kerrville, I will forward it to you and work with Public Affairs for local advertising.

In the meantime, there are no age restrictions for enrolled Veterans to receive their vaccination. We currently have vaccine and appointments available Monday – Friday, 10:00 AM – 2:00 PM, for 150 Veterans. Many of those appointments go unfilled with 96 being the most Veterans we've vaccinated on a given day. For example, this Monday, 5 APRIL 21, only 33 of 150 appointments are filled. Please spread the word we have the vaccine and appointments for enrolled Veterans, and our process is efficient, with patients leaving campus with 30 minutes of arriving. To schedule an appointment, 877-537-7348 or 210 949-9702. (PS, I used the 210 number just now, 4 minutes until it was answered and soon, another upgrade to our telephone system will be completed over the weekend of 16 APR).

Also, if you have thoughts as to why the demand from Veterans has dropped off since we vaccinated nearly 600 on 16 JAN, please let me know.
